Subject: **ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT ANNUAL NOTIFICATION**

All LEARN buildings that are occupied by LEARN employees and students have been inspected by an accredited and licensed inspector as required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 (AHERA) and the State Department of Health. Federal and State Regulations require Local Education Agencies (LEA) to identify Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM) in their school building and to take appropriate actions to control the release of asbestos fibers.

An Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) has been prepared by an accredited and licensed asbestos management planner as required by AHERA and the State Department of Health. The AMP, as well as abatement projects, response actions, three year re-inspections and six month periodic surveillance activity are available for review during normal business hours, in the program administrative office without cost or restriction, to representatives of EPA and the State of Connecticut, school district personnel, their representatives, parents or legal guardians and the public.
